Terms & Conditions

- ◆ Disclaimer: Beer; as real ale is a living product, not all beers will settle as quickly as others. This may mean not all beers will be available all the time. However as soon as any beer becomes ready for drinking it will be on sale.
- ◆ Disclaimer: Personal Property; Wilburton Beer Festival Organisers are not liable for any loss or damage to property, however caused. Those attending the Wilburton Beer Festival are reminded to keep personal property and bags with them at all times.
- ◆ The Chairman, committee and their appointed stewards reserve the right to refuse admission to this event or evict persons at any time. Admission to the festival on Saturday will normally end at 21.30pm, *or earlier at the discretion of the committee. There will be no re-admission after the gates close.*
- ◆ Only drink purchased at the festival may be consumed on the festival site. Bottled drinks or other alcoholic beverages will not be allowed to be brought on to the site.
- ◆ Food not purchased on the site may be consumed at the discretion of the Beer Festival Committee.
- ◆ No refunds on entry.
- ◆ Photos and videos may be taken for publicity purposes. Any close ups of children will not be used without the permission of parent or guardian having been obtained.
- ◆ Disclaimer: Vehicles parked in available car parks are parked at the owners own risk.
- ◆ The Wilburton Beer Festival Committee is not responsible for unaccompanied children. Parents and carers are responsible for the welfare for children they bring to the festival at all times.
- ◆ The Wilburton Beer Festival Committee will prosecute any person found causing wilful damage.
- ◆ For the duration of the Beer Festival, access to Wilburton Recreation Ground, including the adjacent football field, is for the Beer Festival only, by permission of Wilburton Parish Council.
- ◆ No pets are allowed on site except for assistance dogs.
- ◆ No abuse of Beer Festival staff or other festival goers is tolerated.
- ◆ Random bag searches may be carried out by trained security staff.
- ◆ In the case of emergency all persons are to follow any instruction given by Beer Festival Security.
- ◆ Persons leaving the festival must respect the local residents and keep the noise down.
- ◆ Admission to the festival and entry to the site also entails acceptance of the Wilburton Beer Festival Terms and Conditions.
